Dear Interim Provost Stephenson:

Consistent with the Board's goal of affordability and the Systemwide General Education (GE) framework [detailed herein](#), if an academic program wishes for a transfer student to complete a specific GE course to satisfy a GE bucket requirement on its campus – even when the transfer student completed the systemwide GE or the applicable discipline bucket requirement through systemwide transfer coursework – it shall submit a request to the President and CEO.

The programs and courses on the next page have been reviewed and are contingently approved for Academic Year 2024 - 2025. Beginning with Academic Year 2025 – 2026, the courses approved for exception will need to be included in the programs. We stand ready to provide technical assistance if requested.

Additionally, a blanket exception has been granted for Elementary Education based on the licensure and accreditation issues and recent work on the Systemwide Elementary Education (PK-6) transfer associate degree. Transfer credit for Elementary Education majors will be applied consistent with this [guidance](#).
