Bachelor of Applied Science in Human Services:
Addiction Counseling Emphasis

Program eligibility

Students who have completed an Associate in Science degree in Addiction Counseling at DVC are eligible to earn the Bachelor of Applied Science in Human Services with an Addiction Counseling emphasis at Washburn University.

Note: Students may begin the program before completion of the associate degree, but must receive the associate degree to be eligible to receive the BAS degree.

Overall Degree requirements

- a. Minimum of 124 semester hours of credit (60 semester hours must be from Washburn University or other four year college or university)
- b. Minimum of 84 graded hours
- c. Minimum of 45 hours of upper division work (Junior-Senior level courses)
- d. Minimum of 30 hours from Washburn University, with either 20 of the last 30 or 40 of the last 60 hours from Washburn
- e. Cumulative gpa of at least 2.0
