



Master of Social Work (MSW)

Advanced Standing (Full & Part-Time) Sample Schedule

The Advanced Standing program is designed for students who have an undergraduate degree in social work from a program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. The advanced standing program begins in the summer semester of each year. Full-time students complete the program in one year (3 semesters), and part-time students typically complete the program in two years.

A full-time, advanced standing student’s academic plan (33 credit hours) may look like this:
