The *Lean Six Sigma: Green Belt* course delves into the DMAIC process through in-depth information, analysis, and application of Six Sigma and Lean concepts that can be immediately applied to projects and for leading and managing process improvement teams. The course is designed to certify participants as competent in the fundamentals of the *Lean Six Sigma: Green Belt* body of knowledge as defined by Washburn University. Prior participation in the *Washburn University Lean Six Sigma: Yellow Belt* course or similar program is strongly encouraged. A Washburn University Certificate of Completion: Green Belt will be awarded upon successful completion of all program requirements which includes full participation in all class sessions, homework and reading assignments, competency examinations, and a project.

Materials: All course books and handouts are included. Participants must have a laptop with the Minitab Statistical Software and be familiar with basic use and applications. The Minitab software is available as a part of the registration for an additional fee. Lunch and refreshments are also provided.
