Washburn University is committed to international education and to providing funds to help defray the cost of international travel related to an approved study abroad program. The amount of award is based on such factors as cost and length of the program, number of applicants, and available funds. An additional amount may be awarded based on the strength of the application, which typically includes GPA, statement of purpose, and recommendations.

Eligibility:

- The applicant must be enrolled at Washburn University as a degree-seeking student at the time of applying. Students who have not yet completed a semester of study may petition the OIP for admissions.
 - The applicant must have completed at least 12 WU hours with a minimum GPA of 2.0, at the time of applying, with the intention to continue enrollment at WU upon completion of the study abroad program.
- Applicants may apply for **ONE** of the following scholarships offered through the Office of International Programs:

1. International Programs (IP) Scholarship: Available to WU undergraduate and graduate students.

2. Washburn Transformational Experience (WTE) Scholarship: Available to undergraduate students who are completing their approved study abroad program as an [International Education-Washburn Transformational Experience \(WTE\)](#).

Departmental Scholarship for Foreign Language Majors
