High School GPA at least 3.0 on 4.0 scale and ACT score at least 24

LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Accepting a leadership scholarship commits a student to participate in Washburn's Leadership Institute, and is more than just an award-based scholarship. Annual renewal of a leadership scholarship is contingent upon maintaining a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, making appropriate annual progress toward the Leadership Minor or Leadership Studies Certificate, and meeting performance and program participation criteria as determined by the Institute Director.
