



Scholarship Acceptance Form

Terms & Conditions

I understand that to qualify for the leadership scholarship, I must fulfill the Washburn University Admission and Scholarship requirements and be certified eligible for financial aid by the Washburn University Financial Aid Office. Furthermore, I understand that I must continue to maintain eligibility at Washburn University in order to renew this scholarship for up to four (4) years.

I also understand that acceptance of this scholarship requires a responsibility to meet specific expectations, including:

- 1) Attending Washburn University full-time (part-time attendance will result in a prorated scholarship award);
- 2) Maintaining at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA;
- 3) Achieving satisfactory annual progress toward earning a Leadership Studies Certificate as indicated in the Satisfactory Annual Progress section below;
- 4) Completing 2009 Leadership Institute Orientation to be held after the start of the fall semester;
- 5) Actively participating in a leadership development workshop during each of my four (4) years in the Leadership Institute;
- 6) Performing a student leader role during each of my four (4) years in the Leadership Institute as approved by the Leadership Institute Director or Associate Director;
- 7) Meeting at least once each semester with the Leadership Institute Director to jointly review and update my program goals and objectives; and
- 8) Applying for scholarship renewal each year through the Washburn University Financial Aid Office before the priority deadline (currently February 15).

I am aware that the amount of this scholarship may be reduced or canceled if:

- 1) I give false information on my application(s) or this form;
- 2) I engage in misconduct that calls for disciplinary action from Washburn University; or
- 3) I voluntarily withdraw from the Leadership Institute.

Satisfactory Annual Progress

- 1) Successful completion of LE 100, LE 200, LE 300 and LE 400. LE 100 must be taken during your first year at Washburn, followed by LE 200 during your second year, LE 300 during your third year and LE 400 during your fourth year.
- 2) A grade of C or better must be earned in each of the leadership courses.
- 3) Annual participation and/or student leadership in the Leadership Institute as outlined above or approved by the Leadership Institute Director.
- 4) Development of a thoughtful, high quality thank you letter to the scholarship donor(s) received in the Leadership Institute Office by September 30th to be forwarded to your donor.

I understand that if I make satisfactory annual progress toward earning a Leadership Studies Certificate, participate in the activities outlined above and achieve my annual performance goals, my scholarship can be renewed annually for a maximum of three (3) additional years. I further understand that if I receive notification of an additional scholarship or additional financial aid, I will immediately notify the Leadership Institute Office and the Financial Aid Office, and my financial aid package may be reduced to comply with the federal policy regarding the maximum financial aid a student may receive.

Scholarship Eligibility

The award of this scholarship is conditioned upon the student remaining eligible to receive the scholarship for the complete academic term for which it is awarded and paid. Should the student become ineligible for the award during the term for which it is awarded and paid, the student will be financially obligated to repay the source of the scholarship the amount of the award less any refund, if applicable, and/or any unexpended scholarship amounts remaining in the student's account.
