

Senior Academy for High School Students



The Senior Academy is the culminating capstone of the Washburn University® **Accelerated College Experience (ACE)**. Students enroll in 9 credit hours (WU 101 and two of the General Education courses shown below) at half of the normal tuition and complete a preliminary academic and career plan as part of the **Academy**. Students who complete at least 15 hours of **ACE** courses (including the **Academy**) with a 3.0 GPA will receive a one-year \$1,000 scholarship to Washburn University in 2014-2015 in addition to any other financial aid for which they qualify.*

Prerequisites

- ✓ High school senior with a 3.0 GPA or higher
- ✓ Completion of 6 credit hours of other **ACE** college courses with a 3.0 GPA or higher
- ✓ Letter of recommendation from your school superintendent, principal, or counselor
- ✓ Parent or legal guardian approval if under 18
- ✓ Submission of the **Senior Academy** application by November 15, 2013
