## *Distinguished Service Award*

*This award recognizes alumni who have made personal and professional contributions to society, demonstrated exemplary support to the Washburn University Alumni Association and the community, been of service to humanity, distinguished themselves in their careers and brought honor to Washburn through their accomplishments.*



### **Carol (Lyon) Vogel, ba '67, Topeka**

An alumna, longtime professor and administrator, Carol (Lyon) Vogel summarized her connection to Washburn: "I think it is safe to say that Washburn IS my career and inseparable from my life."

Vogel received a bachelor of arts in German in 1967 from Washburn and began teaching at the university two years later after receiving a master of arts from the University of Kansas.

She was a full-time instructor of German from 1969 to 1974, then worked half-time as instructor of German and half-time as director of equal opportunity from 1974 to 2010.

Vogel, a native and resident of Topeka, has been working half-time as director of equal opportunity since 2010 and is retiring this year.

She has been a board member for the Brown Foundation for Educational Equity, Excellence and Research, for 27 years and on the alumnae board for Kappa Alpha Theta since 1970.

Among many other service activities, she is the campus advisor for Nonoso and campus ministry, as well as a member of Phi Kappa Phi.

## *Lilla Day Monroe Award*

*This award honors women who have distinguished themselves as teachers, instructors, administrators or benefactors at Washburn and also have given service to the community and/or their chosen professions. The award is named after suffragist, lawyer and publisher Lilla Day Monroe.*



**Cynthia (Schmidt) Heath, ba '71,  
Chesterfield, Mo.**

Cynthia (Schmidt) Heath credits Washburn for “reinforcing my competitive drive,” which she developed while competing in gymnastics and participating in campus activities.

The 1971 alumna and Topeka native has enjoyed a successful career in multiple fields, first as a social science teacher at Topeka West High School. She later worked in private practice as an attorney at Lewis, Rice & Fingersh, L.C. before serving as employee benefits council for Emerson Electric Co., a \$24-billion manufacturing company in St. Louis, Mo.

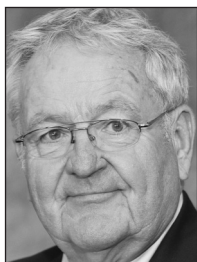
Heath, a Washburn University Foundation trustee, currently is the vice president of executive compensation for Emerson.

She is a member of Nonos and Delta Gamma, and was an honorary order of coif and honor scholar at Washington University, St. Louis, where she received a law degree.

Heath's other service endeavors include Action for Autism, Girl Scouts of Eastern Missouri, Washington University Eliot Society, Center on Executive Compensation and Conference Board Executive Compensation Council. She also is a member of the Missouri and Illinois Bars.

### **Gary Baker, longtime professor of finance, Topeka**

Gary Baker's tenure has extended multiple generations, a fact he relishes.

"I like hearing 'My mom or dad was in your class a very long time ago,'" he said. "I enjoy students returning to campus and saying something like 'That was a good class, thanks.'"

The Worthington, Ohio, native received a bachelor's degree from Ohio State University, master's degree from Wichita State University and a doctorate from the University of Nebraska, Lincoln, and began teaching at Washburn in 1975.

During his tenure, Baker has been honored with the Jack and Betty Dicus Excellence in Teaching and Ned Fleming Excellence in Teaching Awards.

In addition to teaching, he provides economic analysis for attorneys and has served on the board of directors for two Topeka firms.

Baker's service to the community includes volunteering for the Boy Scout Merit Badge program at Washburn and serving as a pilot for the Angel Flight program.

## *Graduate of the Last Decade (GOLD) Award*

*This award honors recent Washburn graduates who demonstrate leadership in career or civic endeavors and loyalty to Washburn. Recipients of the award must have graduated within the past 10 years (since 2003 for this year's banquet).*



### **Ingrid Bego, ba '03, Hastings, Neb.**

Berat, Albania native Ingrid Bego refers to Washburn as the “cornerstone of who I am today professionally, but also in my personal life.”

Crediting mentors such as Carol Vogel and Bob Beatty for influencing her during college, Bego has enjoyed a successful career in higher education.

The 2003 alumna of Washburn, who also has a master of arts and doctorate of philosophy in political science from Washington State University, is an assistant professor of political science at Hastings College in Hastings, Neb.

Bego is a referee for Political Research Quarterly and panel chairwoman of the Midwest Political Science Association. She also serves on the women and gender studies committee and international/diversity programs advisory group at Hastings College.

Bego's community service includes being a member of the YWCA diversity board and Multicultural Alliance of Hastings. She formerly volunteered as an English as a second language teacher in Broomfield, Colo., and at an elementary school in Superior, Colo.
