

WASHBURN UNIVERSITY ART SCHOLARSHIP 2010-2011

Washburn University Art faculty are actively seeking top quality scholarship applicants for the 2010-2011 academic year. Each student interested in applying for scholarship consideration must comply with the following procedures:

1. A letter of introduction and request for scholarship consideration.
2. 2 letters of recommendation from a faculty member or high school teacher. Current WU art majors may ask faculty to place their name on the recommendation list in the Department office in lieu of letters.
3. A copy of your transcript and a list of art or academic awards.
4. Portfolio of exactly **TEN (10)** artworks in a variety of media. We require a CD of digital images. All images should be labeled with name, media, size and date.
OR
Art History applicants should submit a sample of writing done for an Art History or other humanities class. In addition, they must write a paragraph explaining why they are interested in art history. This statement may be part of the letter of introduction.
5. Continuing students must complete the Financial Aid Renewal form available from the Financial Aid Office or on-line:
www.washburn.edu/financial-aid.
6. New students must complete the Washburn Application for Admission and Scholarship form.
7. You must be declared as an Art major, BA or BFA, and enrolled as a full-time student for 2010-11 to be considered for a scholarship.

All materials must be delivered to the Art Department, AB 101, by 4:00 p.m., Feb. 15, 2010.
