- student has a score of at least "3" on the Mathematics Advanced Placement Test.

Rhythmic Proficiency Exam (RPE)

Students must pass the RPE exam prior to earning the BA in Music

Transformational Experience TE (entry date of 2006 or later)

Students entering a degree program in the Fall of 2006 or later must complete a TE prior to graduation.

Double Jury Examination

Students who wish to receive upper division credit for private lessons/ensembles must successfully pass a "Double Jury" examination prior to their enrollment in upper division lessons/ensembles.

III. Electives, 27 hours

Electives may be taken in any department of the University except Music. However, ensemble credit, or private lessons, or group piano (beyond the 8 hours required in the major), up to 15 hours, may be counted in these non-music electives.
