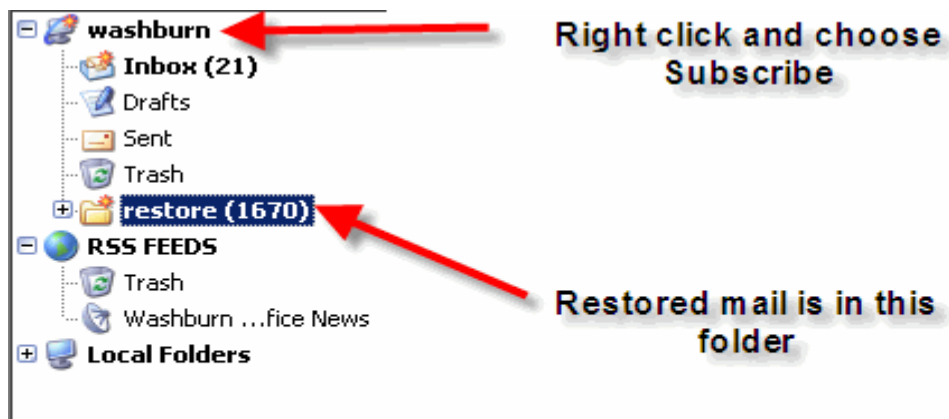
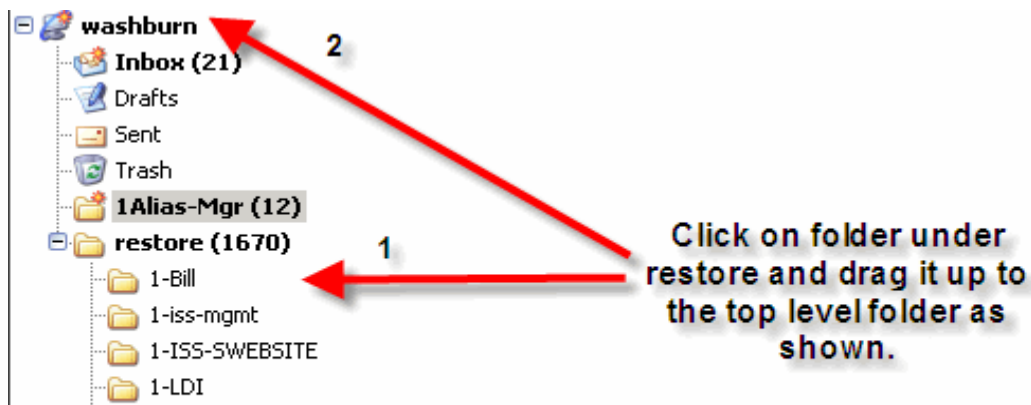


Restoring e-mail in Thunderbird

1. You must subscribe to folders again before they will be visible. Right click on the top most folder as shown and choose Subscribe. Select the + sign next to restore to see all of the folders beneath it. Check the checkbox next to all folders, click subscribe and select OK.
2. Look for the folder named "**restore**". The restored mail will be in this folder.
Note: All messages in this folder will show as unread



3. To move a folder out of the restore folder back to the original location, do the following. Click on the folder and drag it and drop it in the top most folder as shown in the graphic below.
4. Repeat step 3 until all folders have been moved back to the original location.



Some Thunderbird users may see an error message:

The current command did not succeed. The mail server responded: Mailbox does not exist.

If you hold down the Enter key you should be able to automatically go through the multiple messages. Your e-mail will still be there. This message may be seen when moving large folders that haven't been viewed yet.
