WHAT IS BUSINESS INDEX ASAP?

- A database containing articles on management issues, economic indicators and business theories and practices, as well as on the activities of companies and industries worldwide.
- Includes some fulltext articles, abstracts and citations

WHERE DO I FIND BUSINESS INDEX ASAP?

- Connect to Mabee Library at <http://www.washburn.edu/mabee/>. (Off-campus users will need to enter their name and Washburn Identification number located on their Washburn ID)
- Select *Electronic Databases*, then look in the Alphabetical List for **Business Index ASAP** (or look in the Subject List under *Business & Economics*).

HOW DO I START SEARCHING?

- Select which type of search you wish to perform: Subject guide, Keyword, Advanced, or Journal. Keyword or Advanced search are recommended.
- Enter search term(s), set limits (to full-text articles, to peer reviewed or refereed journals, or by date), and click on "Search."

- Towards the bottom of the record is the heading “View other articles linked to these subjects.” The main subject headings of this particular article are listed.
- Click on the “View” button to see a list of other articles given this subject heading, or
- Click on the “See also” button to explore additional subdivisions of the main subject heading.

HOW DO I PRINT AN ARTICLE?

- In the “Text” format of the article, click on the  **Print** button at the top of the record. The article will be reformatted for printing, and the browser print box will open automatically. Click “Print.”
- **OR**, go back to the “citations,” and select the .pdf format of the article (if you’re not already viewing the PDF file). Follow the Acrobat™ Reader print commands.

An argument is developed and tested that a superior's perceived leadership style affects subordinates' information inquiry in an organizational setting. Transformational and transactional leadership theories were utilized to postulate that the content and frequency of information sought by a subordinate from his/her superior will vary depending on that superior's leadership style. This relationship was tested with individual difference predictors such as job-related tolerance for ambiguity, organization-based self-esteem, and work-domain goal orientation of subordinates, in mind. Empirical results, based on the field study using survey data and longitudinal checklist recording, show general support for the model.
