The business minor, designed to provide the non-business student with an understanding of the essentials of business methods and practices, consists of nine hours in accounting and economics (EC201, EC202, and AC224), three hours in management (BU342 or BU345 or BU346), and nine additional hours of accounting, business, or economics courses, of which six must be at the upper division level. These nine additional hours are to be selected by the student in consultation with a business advisor. A grade of C or better must be earned in each course used to satisfy the requirements for a minor. Half of the hours used to meet the requirements of the minor must be earned at Washburn University.
