



Dale Marcoux Leadership Scholarship

WU Professor Leaves Legacy of Leadership

Dale Marcoux was a business professor at Washburn University from 1939 to 1973 who bequeathed \$1.9 million to the university to be designated for School of Business Leadership scholarships.

A native of Havensville, Marcoux's dedication to the university reflects his 34 years of service as an economics professor. His teaching career included positions at Circleville High School and Southwestern College in Winfield, in addition to his post as chair of the WU department of economics and business administration.

This endowed scholarship will provide scholarships for many, many years to come and reflects Dale's commitment to students, especially those with a strong academic background and the promise of becoming future leaders.

To Apply for the Dale Marcoux Leadership Scholarship:

Students interested in applying for this prestigious scholarship must submit the requested information on the back of this flyer, as well as a short typed essay detailing how they have proven leadership skills.

Incoming freshmen must have scored a 26 or higher on the ACT and have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be eligible. Current students and transfers with more than 24 hours completed must have a cumulative college GPA of 3.25 or higher to be eligible.
