2 + 2 PLAN STUDENT CONTRACT

The contract must be completed and received by the Washburn University Financial Aid Office before financial aid can be disbursed. You must hold an Associate's degree in order for the Washburn University Financial Aid Office to process your financial aid. If you do not have your Associate's degree, the community college that you attend will process your financial aid.

Thoroughly read the Student Contract and complete all requested information. Incomplete applications will delay disbursing of financial aid. Once the Washburn University Financial Aid Office is in receipt of the Student Contract, the Consortium Agreement will be sent to the host school for certification.

The Consortium Agreement is between the home school (Washburn University) and the host school (community college). It must be complete and on file before financial aid can be disbursed. Below is a financial aid checklist that will assist you in applying for financial aid:

_____ Complete the 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Priority deadline date is February 15, 2009. The FAFSA can be completed on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

_____ Academic scholarships are awarded based upon a 3.0 GPA or higher. If you are an entering student at Washburn University, your admissions application serves as the academic scholarship application. For continuing students, you must complete the academic scholarship application, provided by the Washburn University Financial Aid Office. Priority deadline date is February 15, 2009. Academic scholarships are based upon Washburn University credit hours only.

_____ Apply for admission to Washburn University as a 2+2 PLAN student. Be sure to include the \$20 application fee. All final academic transcripts must be on file with the Washburn University Admissions Office before financial aid can be disbursed.

_____ Complete and return the Student Contract to the Washburn University Financial Aid Office. (Student must enroll in three credit hours through Washburn University in order to have financial aid processed.)

_____ If you enroll in credit hours at a community college, a Consortium Agreement must be signed by both home and host institution before your financial aid can be disbursed. The consortium agreement will be sent to the host school once the signed Student Contract is received by the Washburn University Financial Aid Office.

_____ In order to monitor Satisfactory Academic Progress, your grades are reviewed at the end of each semester. If you enroll at a host community college, you must request that the Registrar's Office send your official academic transcript to Washburn University's Admissions Office. (There may be a charge for this request.) Financial aid will not be released until the academic transcript from the host community college has been received and reviewed.

I understand that Washburn University will apply its published Satisfactory Academic Progress policy and the Federal Return of Title IV policy to determine my continued financial aid eligibility. To review these policies go to www.washburn.edu/financial-aid/policies.html.
