**** Thefts Reported in Living Learning Center ****

Reported Offense:

The Washburn University Police is investigating four reports of thefts within the LLC in the last week. These thefts are taking place during daytime hours while there are students walking around inside the building. Students are urged to keep their suite doors locked at all times. If there is a problem with the door or the lock, please contact the Residential Living office.

Suspects:

One of the victims reported seeing a black male approximately 5' 10" tall with a medium completion, open the door to their suite around the time of the other thefts, the suite door was unlocked. When asked by the occupant to identify himself, the black male closed the door and left. It is possible this person is a student and a resident of the Living Learning Center. It is possible that this person may have knowledge about these events. Washburn University Police have not identified this person as a suspect at this time; however we are trying to identify and contact him.

When conditions exist that pose a threat to the students, faculty, staff and visitors of Washburn University, it is the duty of the University to give warning of possible "dangerous conditions" on or near the campus.
