

1. Identify individuals for initial 2009 H1N1 intranasal live attenuated vaccine administration in the following target groups:
 - a. Non-pregnant persons who live with or care for infants younger than 6 months of age
 - b. Healthcare and emergency personnel, except those who have contact with severely immunosuppressed persons requiring care in a protective environment
 - c. Persons 2 through 24 years of age
 - d. Vaccinate healthy 25-49 year olds after the initial target groups
2. Screen all patients for contraindications and precautions to H1N1 intranasal live influenza vaccine:
 - a. Contraindications: Children younger than 2yrs and adults 50yrs and older; pregnant women; anyone with a weakened immune system or underlying medical condition; anyone in close contact with a person with a *severely* weakened immune system (requiring care in a protected environment, such as a bone marrow transplant unit); serious reaction (e.g., anaphylaxis) after ingesting eggs or after receiving a previous dose of influenza vaccine or an influenza vaccine component as listed on the vaccine package insert; concomitant aspirin therapy in children and adolescents.
 - b. Precautions: moderate or severe illness with or without a fever; history of Guillain-Barré syndrome within 6 weeks of a previous influenza vaccination.
