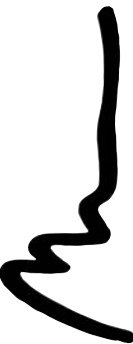

Mulvane Art Museum's Mountain/Plains Art Fair 2010 Artist Agreement and Information

How Do I Apply?

1) Fill out the registration form. **Entries with CD must be postmarked by January 15, 2010.** Artists will be notified of acceptance on or before March 1, 2010. 2) Include three images on CD of your work, and **two checks**, one for the \$250 booth fee (which will be held uncashed pending acceptance) and a second check for \$25 (nonrefundable entry fee). Both checks should be **payable to the Friends of the Mulvane Art Museum.** 3) Send both checks, CD and completed application form to the Mulvane Art Museum's Mountain/Plains Art Fair, 1700 SW College Avenue, Topeka, KS 66621. 4) Artists may withdraw no later than April 1, 2010, without forfeiting booth fees. Jurors will select a maximum of 90 artists and a limited number of alternates. Booth fee checks will be returned to those artists not accepted.

What Qualifies?

All fine art in the following media is eligible, providing the artist has made such a representation to the jurors by CD or statement. Works include painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, jewelry, computer generated art; and works in fiber, glass, wood, bronze, steel, ceramics, and textiles. These shall be original works in the primary contracted medium as stated on the entry. Work from molds, factory assembly, or other commercial methods is not acceptable. Reproductions are allowed to the extent they are clearly marked as such and displayed only in a bin or portfolio, not on display panels. Reproductions should constitute only a minority of the artist's works available for purchase.

Artist Agreement - Please Read

Participating artists are expected to represent their work personally in their booth while the show is open. Artists agree that all work displayed must be original and designed, executed, and signed by the participating artist(s). Whenever two or more artists collaborate on a single work, the names of all the contributing artists must appear on that work. Such collaborative pieces will be deemed single entries. Any unregistered artist sharing a booth will result in the removal of both artists from the show. All artwork displayed in the booth must be available for sale.

Images of artists' work may be used to promote the fair. **No commissions will be charged for sales. 100% of sales go to the artist.**

Entry Format

Entries will be juried by jpegs on one CD only. NO slides, DVDs or video will be accepted. CD must be readable by both Mac and PC. Jpegs must be RGB color mode and at least 800 x 800 pixels and not to exceed 1200 x 1200 pixels. Name each jpeg file to correspond to the entry form using the following format: yourlastname.image1.jpg. Include a printed reference sheet with color thumbnail prints showing each artwork on the CD. Label the CD with artist's full name and telephone number. Place the CD in a protective case for mailing, and include or attach a hard copy of the entry form to the case. Please include a SASE for notification letter and any CD to be returned. Make sure your envelope is of adequate size and bears sufficient postage to accommodate your materials.

Weather Policy

Exhibitors should understand that this is an outdoor art fair, and as such **will continue rain or shine.** Unless the event is cancelled by the Mulvane Art Museum's Mountain/Plains Art Fair Committee, any artist who leaves before the Fair closes without the express consent of the Committee will not be invited to return.

Security

The Washburn University Police Department provides overnight on-site security. Neither the Friends of the Mulvane Art Museum nor Washburn University can assume liability for loss or damage to artwork, and we cannot, of course, assume responsibility for bad weather.

Parking and Admission

Parking and admission is free to all artists. Each exhibitor will receive two free passes and a locator map for his/her booth.

Juried Fair

High standards for art are key to the success of the 2010 Mountain/Plains Art Fair. The Jurors will select a maximum of 90 artists from those who apply.

Jurors

2D - Jane Booth

Jane Booth's works can be found in numerous private and corporate collections as well as featured in the Kansas Governor's offices and chambers. She has a BFA from Kansas State University in Manhattan, Kansas, has studied painting at the Kansas City Art Institute and continues her studies in workshops with other well-known artists. She's represented by galleries in Georgia, California, Missouri, Kansas, and Florida. She has served on the Board and is a long time member of the Kansas City Artists Coalition, and was a recent award winner in the four state River Market Juried Competition in Kansas City, Missouri, and selected for the Governor's Inaugural Book of Notable Kansas Artists.

3D - Ben Ahlvers

Mr. Ahlvers began his role as Gallery Director at the Lawrence Arts Center in the fall of 2009. Prior to that Ben served as Associate Education Director at the Center. Ben has curated exhibitions and coordinated symposiums that have been featured in international publications. He also is an active artist in his own right, exhibiting regularly around the country. Ben received his MFA from Ohio University, in 2004, preceded by a BFA from Southern Illinois University Edwardsville.
