SCHOOL OF APPLIED STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for any School of Applied Studies Scholarships an applicant:

- a) must be a declared major in a School of Applied Studies program; be admitted to a SAS graduate program & maintain six credit hours per semester; new/incoming students must be declared in a SAS program, and enrolled in a minimum of 3 cr hrs/sem in SAS major courses. *NOTE: Admission to the University is NOT the same as Declaring your major.*
- b) must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (specific scholarships may require higher GPA);
- c) scholarships are awarded for a full academic year beginning with Fall semester
- d) both merit and need will be considered in recommending the award. Applicants will be considered for all SAS scholarships for which s/he is eligible.
- e) WIT students are not eligible for SAS Scholarships with the exception of WIT/OA students who are eligible for the SAS Leadership in Office Administration scholarship
- f) Deadline is February 15th.

The School Of Applied Studies Scholarship Application Form

Must have attached the following information:

- a) a Resume, including the applicant's employment, education and professional activities, honors, recognition, community activities, services honors-recognition, professional memberships, offices, services;
- b) a Narration of the events or circumstances which convinced the applicant to major in the particular area and the applicant's long-range professional goals;
- c) a Statement of Need, including disclosure of the financial assistance the applicant will be receiving during the term of the scholarship
- d) a copy of the student's Official & most current transcript(s) in a sealed envelope. *If a current WU student & all transcripts are posted on WU transcript, official WU transcript will suffice otherwise an official transcript from each college/University attended must be attached*

Procedures

The following procedures will be followed in processing scholarship applications:

- a) To assure consideration, a completed application form must be received in Benton 306 by February 15th for the next full academic year.
- c) The SAS School Scholarship Committee will make recommendations to the SAS Dean;
- d) The scholarship recommendation will be forwarded to the Financial Aid Office.
