Spring 2019

The purpose of the spring 2019 enrollment report is to provide information and understanding of current enrollment patterns of Washburn University students. The first section provides a brief summary with comparisons to spring 2018 of undergraduate, graduate, and law enrollment levels. The second section provides a more thorough breakdown for spring 2019 of the WU student body in terms of headcount, registered credit hours, demographics, GPA, and hours earned, along with specific comparisons to spring 2018. Summary tables are provided in the appendix.

Summary

All tables referenced in the summary section can be found in the appendix.

WU headcount enrollment: Total enrolled student headcount was 5894 for spring 2019, which is a decline of 1.7% compared to spring 2018 (Apx. Table 1).

WU credit hours: Total enrolled student credit hours were 63,760 for spring of 2019, which is a decline of 3.2% from spring 2018 (Apx. Table 1).

WU FTE: The full-time-equivalency of student headcount was 4,505 for spring of 2019, which is a decline of 2.6% from spring of 2018 (Apx. Table 1).

FT/PT enrollment: Of the WU student body 64.6% were enrolled as full-time students, and 35.4% were enrolled as part-time students (Apx. Table 1).

Average Credit Hour Load: On average undergraduate students took 12.1 credit hours, non-law graduate students took 7.3 credit hours, and law students took 14.3 credit hours during the spring 2019 term (Apx. Table 1).

Concurrent Enrollment Program: High school student enrollment, which is almost entirely CEP enrollment, was 627 students, which is a 5.2% increase from last spring (Apx. Table 1).

Attendance Pattern: On-campus credit hours or a mix of on-campus and on-line credit hours comprised 87.3% of student credit hours for spring 2019 (Apx. Table 1).

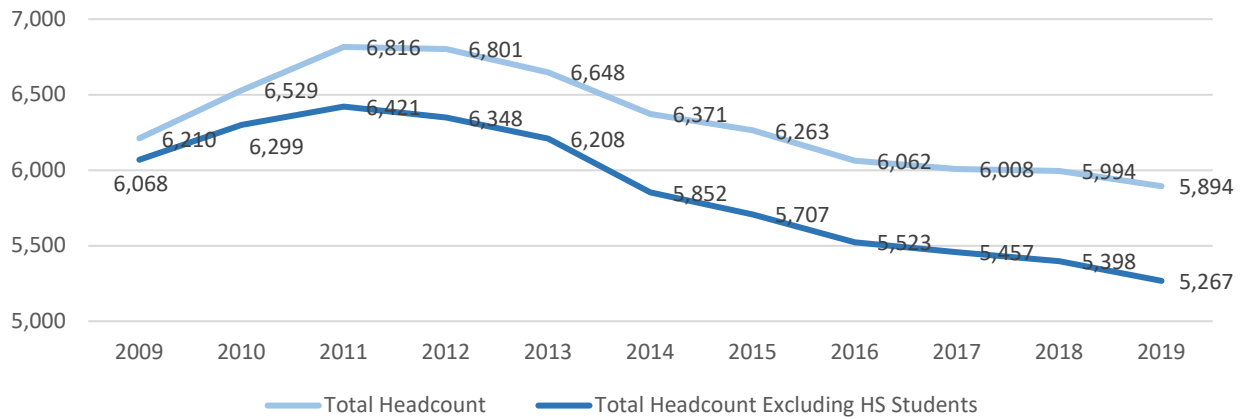
Analysis and Analytics

As an extension to the previous summary this section provides some historical framework and current trends in WU student enrollment for spring 2019.

Basic Counts

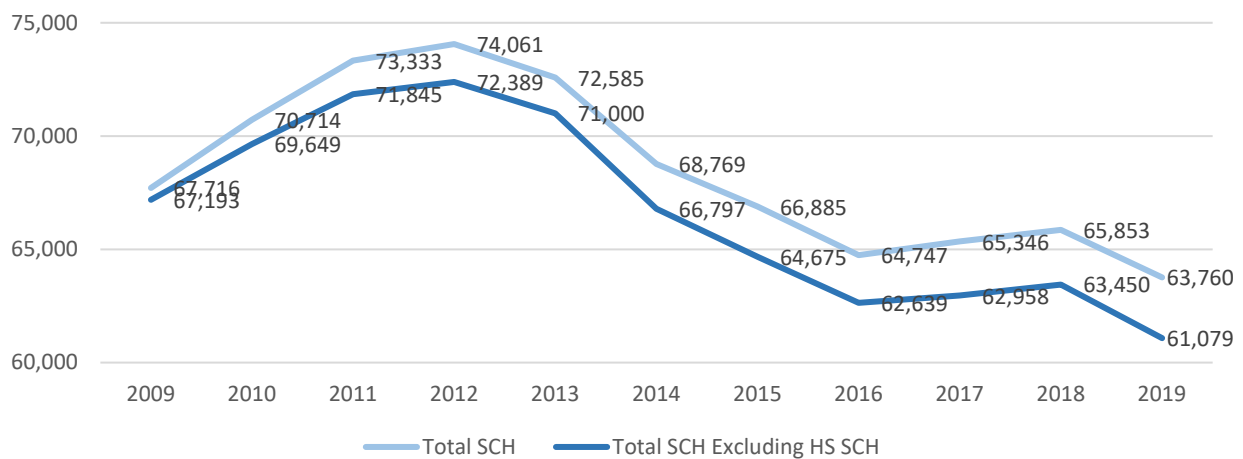
As illustrated in Figure 1, Washburn's spring headcount enrollment has continued to decline since 2011. The decline was largest in 2014 with a 4.17% decrease and smallest in 2018 with a 0.23% decline in student enrollment from the previous spring. Spring 2019 had a 1.67% decline from spring 2018.

WU student credit hour enrollment has fluctuated over the past ten spring terms, with spring 2019 as the minimum. However, the year to year decline was largest in spring 2014 with a 5.3% decrease, where spring 2019 had a 3.18% decrease in student credit hour enrollment.

Figure 2: Washburn Spring 2019 Credit Hour Enrollment

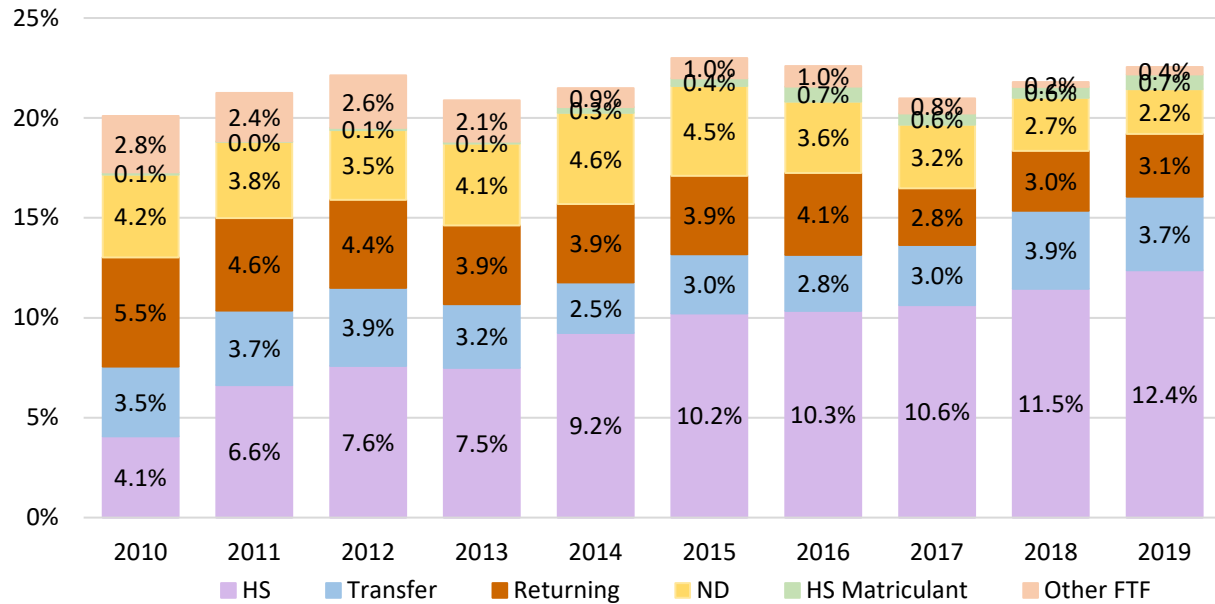


Undergraduate Enrollment

Total undergraduate enrollment has followed the same declining trend as overall enrollment. Over three-quarters of undergraduate enrollment is comprised of continuing students, 77.4% for spring 2019 (94.1% of degree seeking Undergraduates, see Apdx. Table 5). This population has remained steady in proportion to total undergraduate enrollment for the past decade, ranging from 76.6% (in 2015) to 79.4% (in 2010).

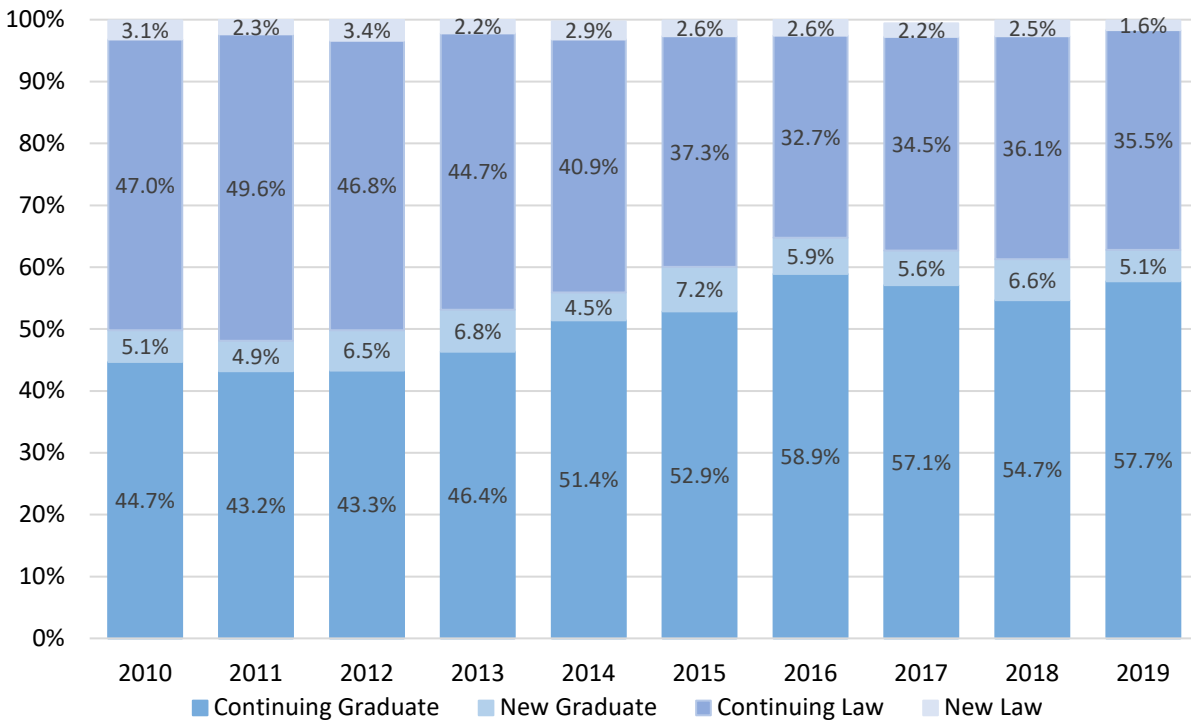
Figure 3. Undergraduate Student Enrollment Rates (excluding continuing students)

The remaining quarter of undergraduate enrollment includes a growing percentage of high school student enrollment in WU’s concurrent enrollment program as illustrated in Figure 3. Also, Figure 3 demonstrates the dwindling trend for non-matriculant freshmen, non-degree seeking, and returning students over the past ten years. This has, in general, meant that fewer students are available to enter the continuing student body and has put increasing pressure to recruit student from the CEP program.

Graduate and Law Students

Graduate and law students, which comprised less than 4% of the total WU student population in spring 2019, increased from the previous spring by 3.4% (see Apdx. Table 1). As demonstrated in Figure 4, while incoming graduate and law headcount remained relatively steady, the continuing graduate student population has tended to increase over the past ten years while the continuing law student population has tended to decline.

Figure 4. Graduate and Law Student Enrollment Rates



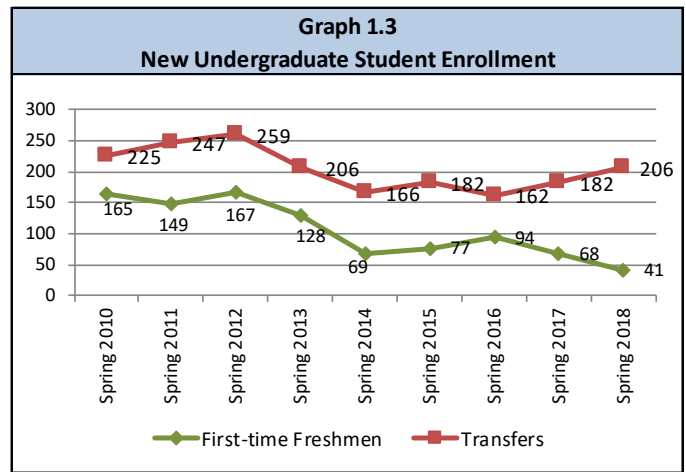
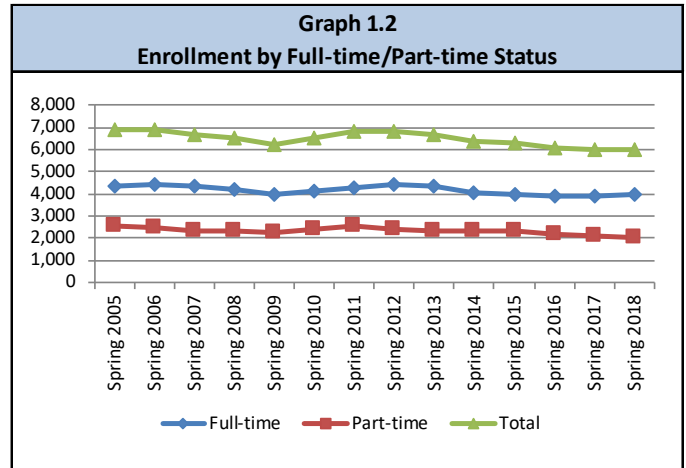
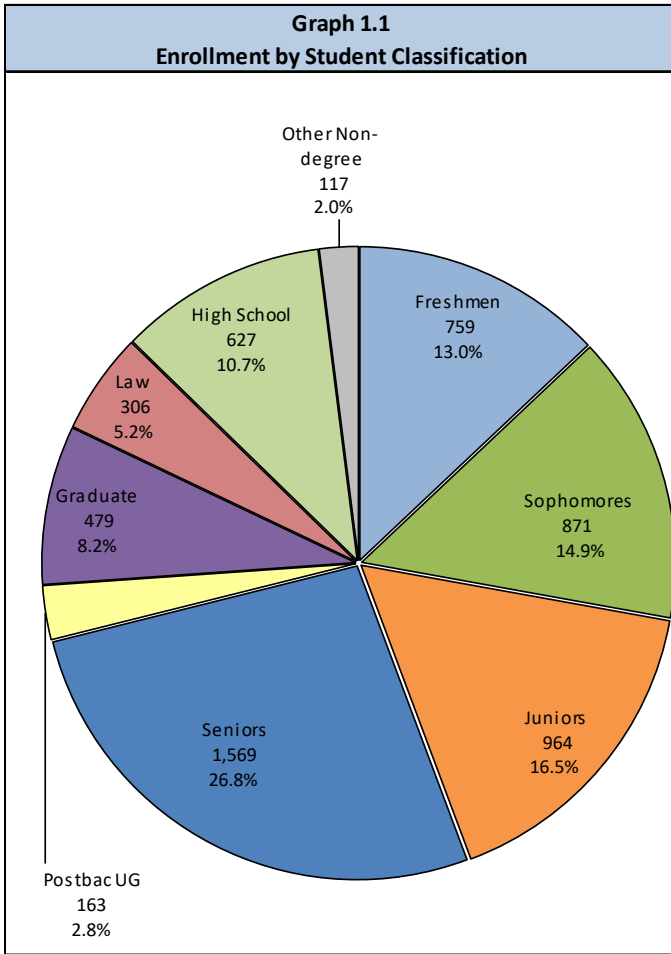

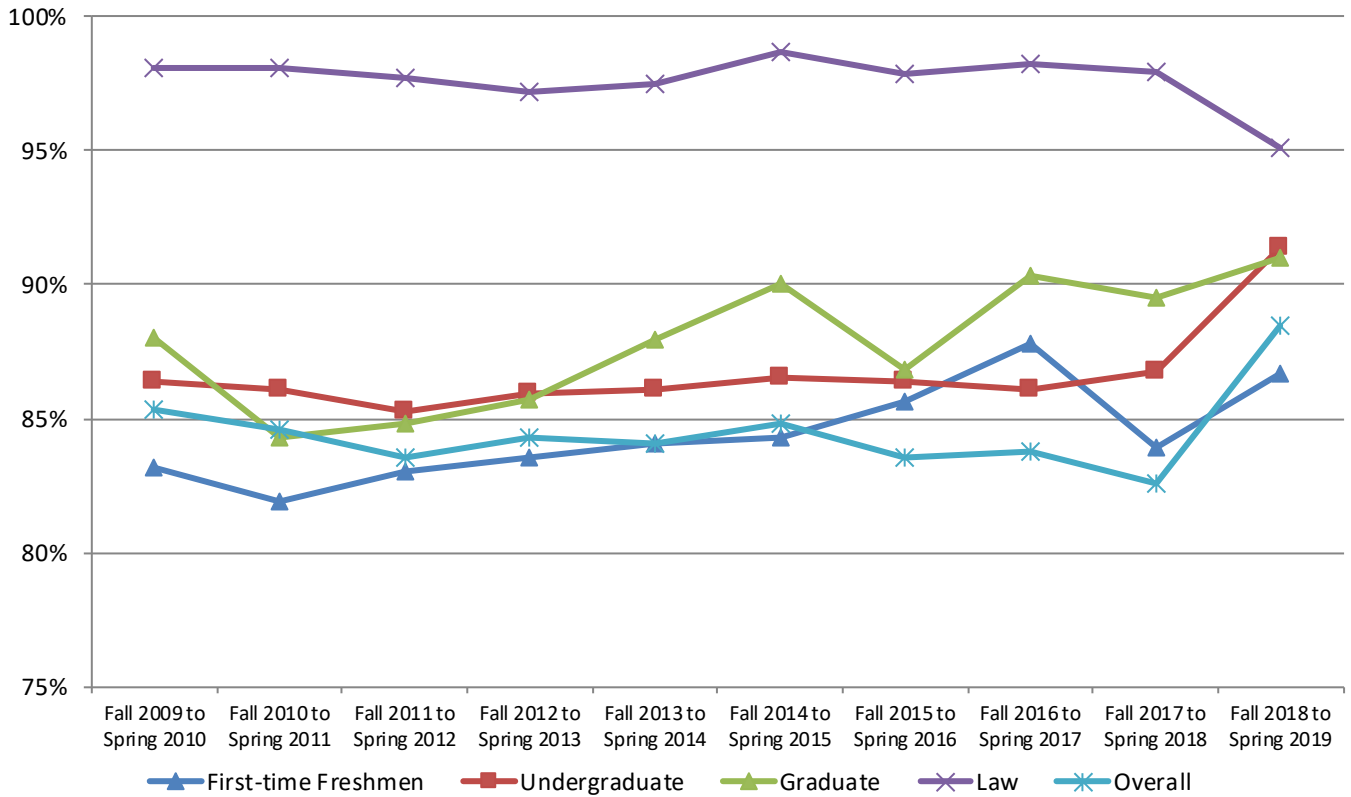
