Spring 2023 Enrollment Report Executive Summary

The Spring 2023 Enrollment Report provides an overview of student enrollment at Washburn University (Washburn) and Washburn Institute of Technology (Washburn Tech) originating from the 20th day census snapshot.

Table 1 and Chart 1 contain headcount, credit hour, and FTE comparisons, as well as summary demographic data, between Spring 2023 and Spring 2022 for Washburn students; Table 2 contains headcount, credit hour, and FTE comparisons between Spring 2023 and Fall 2022 for Washburn students. Tables 3 – 7, Chart 2, and Chart 3 provide longitudinal trends documenting headcount and credit hour changes.

Table 8 contains headcount, credit hour, and FTE comparisons between Spring 2023 and Spring 2022 for Washburn Tech students.

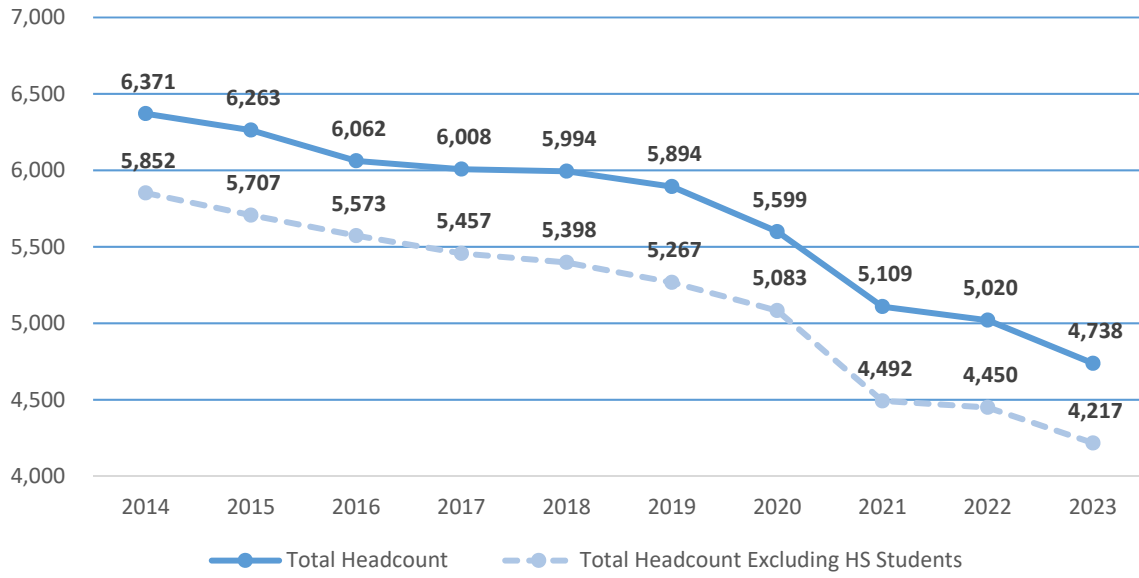


Figure 2: Spring FTE, 2014 - 2023

Figures 1 and 2 – on Page 3 – document changes in Washburn’s Spring enrollment headcount and FTE, including and excluding high school students, for the past ten years (2014-2023).

Washburn Student Headcount and FTE (Figures 1 and 2, pp. 3)

- Spring enrollment headcount and FTE has declined for ten years, with a slight increase in FTE in Spring 2017.

Enrollment Summary (Tables 1 and 2, pp. 4-5)

- Headcount decreased by 237 students (-4.7%) from 5,020 in Spring 2022 to 4,783 in Spring 2023, and decreased by 677 (-12.4%) from Fall 2022 ($n = 5,460$).
- Credit hours decreased by 1,797 (-3.3%) from 54,276 in Spring 2022 to 52,479 in Spring 2023, and decreased by 6,699 (-11.3%) from Fall 2022 ($n = 59,178$).
- FTE decreased by 134 (-3.6%) from 3,758 in Spring 2022 to 3,624 in Spring 2023, and decreased by 444 (-10.9%) from Fall 2022 ($n = 4,068$).
- Degree-seeking student headcount decreased from 4,395 in Spring 2022 to 4,211 in Spring 2023 (-4.2%), and decreased by 388 (-8.4%) from Fall 2022 ($n = 4,599$); non-degree seeking students also decreased by 53 (-8.5%) from Spring 2022 to Spring 2023, by 289 (-33.6%) from Fall 2022.

Undergraduate Enrollment by Student Type (Table 3, pp. 7)

- The first-time freshmen headcount increased from 52 in Spring 2022 to 75 in Spring 2023.
- Transfer students decreased from 168 in Spring 2022 to 129 in Spring 2023.
- In combination, the new student total decreased from 6.2% of the total undergraduate student population in Spring 2022 to 5.9% of the same population in Spring 2023.
- Returning students decreased from 155 in Spring 2022 to 104 in Spring 2023, while continuing students decreased from 3,194 in Spring 2022 to 3,159 in Spring 2023.

Headcount Enrollment and Student Credit Hours (Table 4, pp. 8)

- Full-time headcount increased 0.4% and part-time headcount decreased 14.1% in Spring 2023. This is the first increase in Spring full-time headcount enrollment since Spring 2018.
- Total headcount and student credit hours have decreased year-to-year over a ten-year trend from Spring 2014 to Spring 2023, except in Spring 2017 and 2018 where student credit hours increased.

Headcount by Student Classification and Full-time/Part-time Status (Table 5, pp. 9)

- Seniors continue to comprise the largest percentage of full-time students in Spring 2023 at 27.1%; Freshman overtook Juniors for the second-largest percentage of full-time students in Spring 2023 at 19.3%.
- Seniors and Graduate students comprise the largest proportion of degree-seeking part-time students, with 20.6% and 16.8%, respectively.
- The ratio of full-time to part-time students by classification slightly skewed more towards full-time (68.1%) than part-time (31.9%) during the last five-year period.

Full-time Equivalent Enrollment by Student Classification (Table 6, pp. 10)

- FTE enrollment has decreased year-to-year over a five-year trend, from 4,387 in Spring 2019 to 3,624 in Spring 2023.

Headcount by Gender (Table 7, pp. 11)

- Not Indicated was added as a new category for gender in Spring 2023.
- The proportion of Female students has increased over a ten-year trend, from 59.0% of the total student population in Spring 2014 to 63.2% in Spring 2023.

Washburn Tech Enrollment Summary (Table 8, pp. 12)

- Washburn Tech total headcount enrollment increased by 52 students from Spring 2022 to Spring 2023, a 5.2% increase.
- Washburn Tech student credit hours increased by 212, a 1.6% increase.
- FTE increased by 1.6%, from 887 in Spring 2022 to 901 in Spring 2023.

Figure 1: Spring Enrollment Headcount, 2014 - 2023

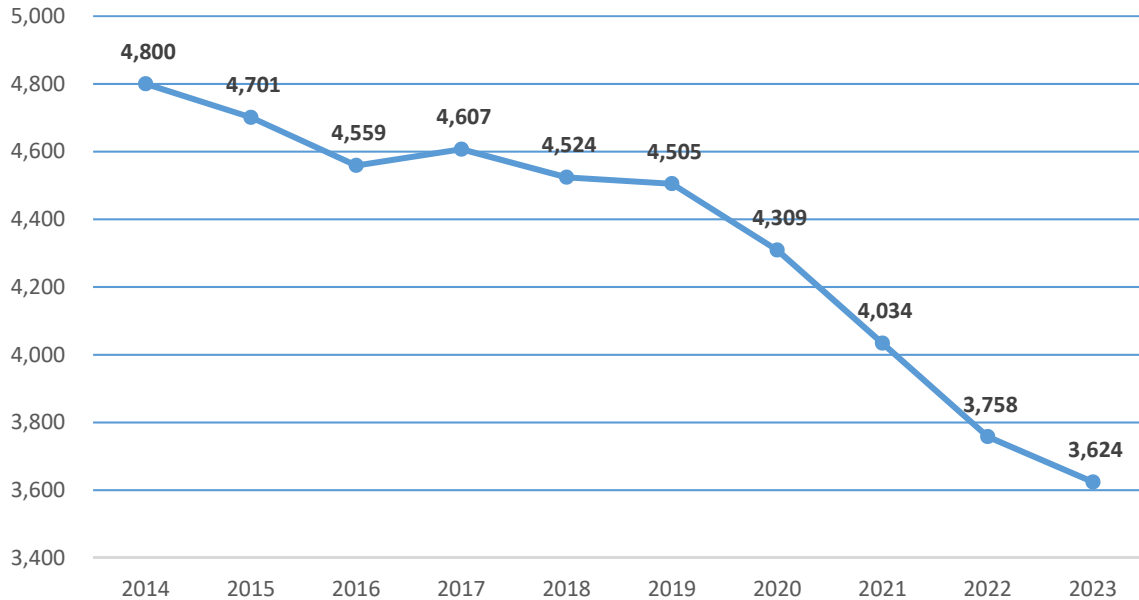

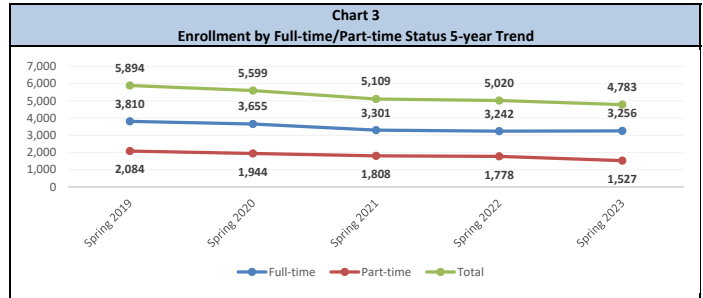
