## Suggested Syllabus Addition for WUmester 2021: Sustainability

This class will participate in Washburn's WUmester initiative. WUmester is intended to foster a campus-wide conversation on a diversity-related topic each spring semester. The goal of the program is to engage students and the entire Washburn community in a cross-disciplinary learning experience on timely subjects and help students see the connections between the subjects they study in the classroom and real-world debates and problems.
