

Barbara L. Buzick Art Scholarship

Application Information 2023-2024

Scholarship Award: This highly-competitive scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman art student with the expectation that if the student maintains satisfactory progress towards their art degree, this full scholarship is renewable up to four years. The fund will provide tuition, books, fees, and art supplies. Payment of housing and board will be awarded to those students residing on-campus. To be eligible, you must declare yourself as an art major and enroll as a full-time student.

Selection of recipient: The selection will be determined by a review committee of 3-5 people, including the Art Department Chair, art department faculty, and outside experts. Portfolios are judged on the following criteria:

- Technical Proficiency
- Visual Design
- Originality
- Expression

Application process: The deadline for all applications will be **March 6, 2023**. All applicants must have completed the Application for Admission and Financial Aid through the Washburn Admission Office. Other application materials should be submitted to the Art Department, following the guidelines listed on the Art Department Scholarship Application.

All applicants will automatically be considered for other Departmental Scholarships ranging from \$1000-\$3000, should they not be selected for the Buzick Scholarship.
