

# Washburn University Biology Department Scholarship Application Form For Incoming Freshman For the 2022-2023 Academic Year

A limited number of competitive, merit-based scholarships are available through the Biology Department for qualified incoming **freshman** students who plan to major in a Biology Department degree program. These are non-renewable, one-year scholarships. Students who plan to remain in the program after the first year will apply each year in January or February for Biology Department Scholarships.

### Qualification Criteria for Freshman Biology Scholarships:

Scholarship recipients will be selected from those applicants who satisfy the minimum criteria listed below.

1. A "B" average in all completed high school courses.
2. A "B" average in all completed college work taken during high school.
3. A composite ACT score of 25 or above

Scholarship recipients are expected to declare a major offered through the Department of Biology, enroll in either BI 102 or CH 151 or both (after meeting with a Biology Department faculty advisor), and participate in the Annual Biology Orientation in the Fall semester. One-half of the scholarship is awarded during the Fall (first) semester at Washburn, with the remainder awarded at the beginning of the Spring semester, provided that the student passes the above-mentioned courses with a grade of "B" or better.
