<p>The Professional Development Unit requirement is meant to ensure that Athletic Training Students become actively involved in the athletic training profession, are integrated into the culture of sports medicine prior to graduation, and are educated about the process of continuing education requirements for maintaining athletic training certification and licensure. 25 PDU's are required annually.</p> <p>It is possible to complete all 25 PDU's required annually without expense or fee; however, some possible expenses include (but are not limited to):</p> <p>NATA Student Membership</p> <p>KATS Student Membership</p> <p>Attendance at annual meetings &amp; symposium</p>	<p>\$99/year</p> <p>\$10/year or included with NATA student membership</p> <p>Varies by symposium.
