

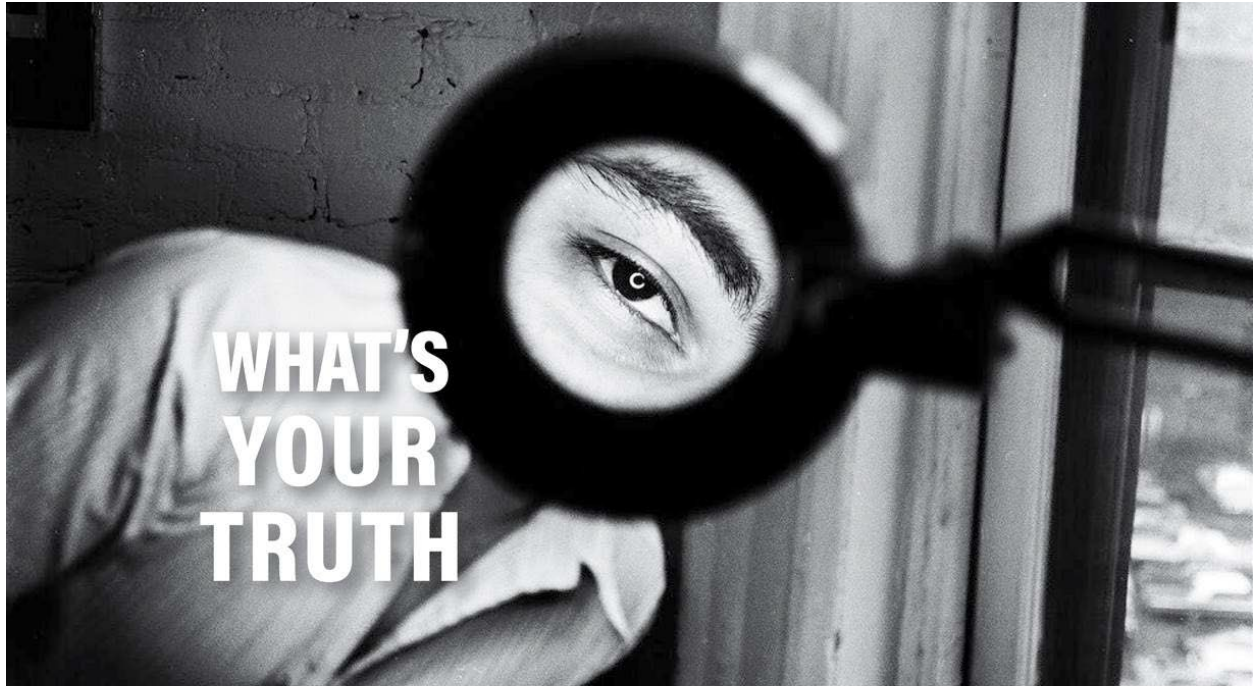

Fall 2021 CAS General Faculty Meeting Minutes
September 8, 2021 3:30 PM
Henderson 100

- I. Welcome & Dean's Opening Remarks Dean Stephenson welcomed everyone and expressed appreciation for the work CAS faculty do every day supporting and inspiring students. Stephenson also shared updates about the following:
 - a. WU rates for both 4- and 6-year graduation have increased by 21% and there has been a 6.4% decrease in DFW rates. Stephenson thanked CAS faculty for their efforts to make this happen, specifically with re-recruitment efforts; development of math pathways program and advising efforts for math placement (increase of 26% in students who pass their math requirement the first time); participation in faculty success groups; development of English pathways and placement; and faculty participation in submitting academic progress reports and early alerts.
 - b. Exciting things going on this year:
 - i. Corrections program—first cohort now in their third semester; recent award of grant to help recruit students to that program.
 - ii. Resumption of international programs.
 - iii. Looks like enrollment will be flat this year—good news after years of declining enrollment.
 - iv. Changes to faculty searches underway to help bring in strong and diverse applicant pools to faculty position postings.
 - v. Restoration of travel grants, large and small research grants, and WTE.
 - vi. Updates to program webpages.
- I. Election of CAS General Secretary—Kelly Erby was nominated and elected.
- II. Approval of Minutes from March 3, 2021 CAS General Faculty Meeting—minutes were approved.
- III. Soliciting CAS Faculty Support for Student Success Initiatives (Dean Alan Bearman from the Center for Student Success and Retention)—Bearman was unable to attend, so Tracy Routsong filled in and provided information about the following CAS collaborations with the Center for Student Success:
 - a. TutorMe provides 24/7 access to tutoring, primarily for gateway courses. Those who have used TutorMe express high satisfaction with the experience, but right now high-performing students are the primary users at WU, not academically at-risk students. Routsong asked CAS faculty to think about how they can encourage/incentivize more students to use TutorMe.
 - b. Appointment scheduling feature in Navigate. This feature allows students to easily schedule appointments with faculty members. Routsong, on behalf of CSSR, Asked more CAS faculty to adopt use of this feature. Christina Foreman (christina.foreman@washburn.edu) can help faculty set this up.
 - c. Success Markers is a new feature in Navigate. Intended to help advisors have conversations with advisees about their academic success. CAS faculty are encouraged to attend Success Marker training offered this fall by CSSR, and participate in the CAS Faculty Success Group option to learn more about success markers.
 - d. Several faculty members asked questions:

- i. Muffy Walter asked how long it typically takes for students who request tutoring to be contacted by a tutor. She has heard anecdotally from students that it can take 48+ hours.
 - ii. Is it possible to get a list of success markers? Erby said she would forward list to CAS chairs once she receives it from CSSR.
- IV. New Business:
 - a. Ratification of College Faculty Council (CFC) Subcommittees- committee assignments were ratified.
- V. Introduction of New Faculty Members-Department chairs introduced their new faculty members, who joined either this fall or in fall 2020:
 - a. Carson Kay, lecturer in Communication Studies, who began at WU in fall 2020.
 - b. Kai Xu, lecturer in Communication Studies, who began at WU in fall 2020.
 - c. Lori Gill, lecturer in Mathematics and Statistics, who began at WU full-time in fall 2020 as math success coach
 - d. Gary Hu, assistant professor of Mathematics and Statistics, who began at WU in fall 2020
 - e. Jillian Kimzey, math lab manager, who began at WU this fall 2021.
 - f. Lucy Tan, lecturer in Music, who began at WU in fall 2020.
 - g. Stacy Uthe, lecturer in Music, who began at WU this fall 2021.
 - h. Tucker Jones, lecturer in Psychology, who began at WU this fall 2021.
 - i. Alex Myers, lecturer in Sociology, who began at WU in fall 2020.
 - j. Grant Armstrong, lecturer in Political Science, who began in fall 2020.
 - k. Hoang Nguyen, assistant professor in Chemistry, who began in fall 2020.
- VI. Announcements
 - a. Travel Funding for 2021–2022- travel funding has been restored for this academic year. Full-time faculty are eligible for \$1100 in scholarly presentation funding and \$550 in professional development funding. No deadline to apply this year; CAS is committed to funding faculty travel.
 - b. Faculty Success Groups Fall 2021- There will be 2 options for faculty success groups this fall:
 - i. All CAS Departments have recently partnered with the Center for Student Success (CSSR) to identify “student success markers” in Navigate. Attend a training on Success Markers offered by CSSR and review the success markers for your department’s programs. As a group, **identify ways your department can help students (through teaching and advising) meet success markers, as well as intervention strategies that may assist students who have missed one or more success markers graduate.**
 - ii. Conduct a Faculty Service Inventory with members of your department to determine the distribution of faculty service in your unit. Use the form provided below. As a group, discuss the results of your inventory. Participating departments will also receive a completed inventory from another department in order to provide a comparison to inform their discussions. Who is doing what types of service in the department? Is service equitably and effectively distributed in your department? Is service adequately recognized in the annual evaluation processes within your

department and in tenure and promotion guidelines? **Make a plan for any changes that may be warranted.**

- c. Dynamic Forms- several paper forms have now moved to the electronic dynamic forms platform, including change of grade forms and annual faculty reports.
- d. [WUmester 2022: Truth](#)-Erby thanked faculty for their participation in previous WUmester efforts and asked everyone to think about how they could incorporate the 2022 topic of Truth into their spring courses.

- f. Tom Prasch shared about upcoming Phi Alpha Theta events.

- h. Cindy Turk shared about the Psychological Services Clinic and opportunities to provide services to community children.
- i. Melanie Burdick shared about upcoming CTEL workshops on antiracist pedagogy.
- j. Ted Schonka shared about upcoming Theatre production “The Show that Goes Wrong.”
- k. Craig Treinen shared about upcoming Mosaic concert and faculty recital.

Bachelor of Education in Elementary Education - Proposed Program Revisions (CIP: 13)

2. Rationale for offering this program.

The BEd in Elementary Educationon has been revised to reflect the changes in standards and best practices in teaching.

3. Exact proposed catalog description.

The K-6 teaching program prepares students to teach in kindergarten through sixth grade classrooms. Students may choose to complete a second license in one of six areas at the same time they complete preparation for the K-6 license.

These areas include:

 - Middle School English/Language Arts (Grades 5-8)
 - Middle School Mathematics (Grades 5-8)
 - Middle School History (Grades 5-8)

What is the program title?

* Bachelor of Science in Computer Information Science with a Concentration in Data Science (CIP: 52.1301)

What is the rationale for the change?

* MA346 and MA384 are only offered in the Fall of even numbered years. A student entering the junior year of this program in odd years would need to wait until their senior year to take these courses. It is advantageous to offer alternatives that are offered in odd years. We propose that the MA346 requirement change to MA342 (odd years) or MA346 (even years) and the MA384 requirement change to MA344 (odd years) or MA384 (even years).
