

Mathematics and Statistics Scholarships

Application form for **Continuing** Middle School Math Students

All Washburn Elementary Education majors who have declared a Middle School Mathematics emphasis and are interested in receiving scholarships from the Department of Mathematics and Statistics **MUST** fill out the form below in order to be considered eligible candidates. Transfer students who intend to declare a major in Elementary Education with a Middle School Mathematics emphasis may also complete this application.

Qualification Criteria for Scholarship Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be selected from those applicants who satisfy the criteria listed below.

1. Be a declared major in Elementary Education with an emphasis in Middle School Mathematics;
2. Earn a grade point average of at least 3.0 overall and at least 2.75 in mathematics courses taken at Washburn numbered 116 and above;
3. Make adequate progress towards earning an Elementary Education Degree with a declared middle math emphasis
4. Pass at least 12 hours per semester.

Then, during the academic year the funds are awarded, scholarship recipients are expected to meet the following criteria. (Applicants may petition the Scholarship Committee for an exception if extenuating circumstances apply.)

1. Be enrolled full-time at Washburn (at least 12 hours per semester);
2. Enroll in at least three hours of mathematics courses at the level of College Algebra (MA 116) or above, or be student teaching, during each academic year.

Scholarship recipients will receive half of their scholarship award during the fall semester at Washburn, with the remainder awarded at the beginning of the spring semester. Award amounts will depend on the student's grades in mathematics courses, and the level of their involvement in mathematics department activities (Math Club, tutoring, etc.).
