Dear Scholarship Applicant,

Each year the faculty of the Department of Modern Languages recognize the meritorious achievements of its majors by awarding financial assistance. We are proud of your hard work and want to support you as much as we can. The funds for these scholarships come from many alumni, former faculty, and organizations that have given generously to support our academic excellence with financial aid for our students majoring in a modern language.

Students that have completed a minimum of 9 hours in either French or Spanish beyond the 100 level courses are eligible to apply for the department scholarships. To ensure all scholarship applicants have an equal opportunity to receive an award, **students who have not received a study abroad scholarship in the awarding year will be given priority**. Early in the spring, the department faculty review the academic performance of its current majors and recognizes them for their achievements within the department. In this small packet, you will find the scholarship application and a list of requirements applicants should meet.

Eligibility & Requirements:

- 1. Must be a major(s) in a Modern Language (French or Spanish).
- 2. Must be currently enrolled in a modern language course.
- 3. Must have completed a minimum of 9 hours beyond the 100 level in either French or Spanish. (students who cannot meet the 9 hour requirement due to a compelling reason are still encouraged to apply and the reason will be taken into consideration).
- 4. Applicants should be enrolled full-time and in good standing (at least 12 credit hours in both fall and spring).
- 5. Must have an overall 3.0 GPA and a minimum 3.0 GPA in the department. (Applicants who hold a 3.5 or higher departmental GPA will be considered for a higher award)
- 6. Acceptance of the reward requires students to enroll in a foreign language course each semester.

Must include the following:

- 1. Scholarship Application with all necessary fields completed.
- 2. A copy of the applicant's unofficial academic transcript.
- 3. A short explanation of how you plan to use your degree in a modern language to enhance your education and future plans. (250 words)
