The Business Minor is designed to provide the non-business student with an understanding of the essentials of business methods and practices. It consists of nine hours in accounting and economics (EC200, EC201, and AC224), three hours in management (BU342 or BU345 or BU346), and nine additional hours of accounting, business, or economics courses, of which six must be at the upper-level division level; the last three must be 200-level or above. These nine additional hours are to be selected by the student in consultation with a business advisor.

A grade of C or better must be earned in each course used to satisfy the requirements for a minor. Half of the hours used to meet the requirements of the minor must be earned at Washburn University. It is the student's responsibility to have the course prerequisites met prior to the beginning of the semester. Prerequisite courses include EN101, MA112 (MA116 recommended), EC200, and EC201, as well as AN112, PY100, and/or SO100 for BU342. 200-level sources require sophomore standing, while 300-level courses require junior standing. Prerequisites are noted to the right of the course name in gray; make sure to complete your course choices in the blue sections.
