

STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIPS FOR BUSINESS BODS ABROAD

WU Study Abroad Scholarships – Awards up to \$2,000

Offered through the Study Abroad Office. Students may select ONE of the following:

i) Study Abroad (SA) Scholarship

Funds provided by the Study Abroad Office through generous support of donors. Available to WU undergraduate and graduate students. Estimated awards: \$1,000 for a semester program, \$500 for a short-term program.

ii) International Education Washburn Transformational Experience (IE-WTE) Scholarship

Funds provided by Washburn University for students completing the International Education Washburn Transformational Experience. Available to WU undergraduate students. Estimated awards: \$1,000- 2,000 for a semester program, \$700-1,000 for a short-term program.

Eligibility Criteria

- Be a currently enrolled degree-seeking student at WU at the time of applying.
- Have completed at least 12 WU hours (undergraduate) or 9 WU hours (Graduate) with a minimum GPA of 2.0 at the time of applying.
- NOT have graduated before the program departs unless the course associated with the program is required for graduation

Application deadline: Spring Break – February 1st / Fall and Summer – March 1st / Winter and Spring – October 15th .

WU School of Business Study Abroad Scholarship - Awards up to \$1,000

Offered through the WU School of Business. May be applied for in addition to one of the scholarships above.

Funds provided through generous support of donors. Estimated awards: \$1,000 for a semester program, \$500 for a short-term program.

Eligibility Criteria

- Open to students who have declared a major in the School of Business and intend to study abroad.
- Must have a cumulative college GPA of 3.0 or higher and a minimum of 24 hours completed.

If offered a scholarship, students must sign and return an acceptance form, write a thank-you letter to the donor, and make a public presentation about their study abroad experience upon their return.

Application deadline: Spring - December 1st / Fall and Summer - April 1st
