Committee welcomed new member Mary Rivera and returning member Mary Sundal.

Minutes of Nov. 14, 2013 were approved.

Zhang reported healthy international student enrollment growth with China, Saudi Arabia and Japan as the leading countries represented and that over 40 Japanese students from Fukuoka and Chiba would be on campus in the following few weeks. McConnell-Farmer reported another successful trip to Belize with students. Glashausser reported the LLM program is ready to accept international students.

“International Health Care” program was approved as a WTE eligible program.

The following faculty funding requests were approved:

Juma’s proposal was not recommended for funding due to a recent award in the same fiscal year and tight budget. Zhang would contact her in the event that funds become available toward the end of the fiscal year.
