Dr. Bearman, Ms. Croucher, Dr. Hull, Ms. Onek, Mrs. Masterson, Dr. Reynard, Mr. Thomas, Dr. Wilkerson sent word they would be unable to attend.

Assistant Dean Judy Druse reminded everyone to check with their library liaisons to see if their department has been approved for a one time special purchase through Endowment funds. Continue to think about a “wish list” that your department would like to purchase in case funding becomes available.

The first drafts of the WU Strategic Plan Subcommittee’s “White Papers” will go online tomorrow for a week to get input from the Washburn community. After the five reports are revised and combined, the final report will be submitted to the President and Board of Regents for their review. The final report should be available in March 2010. Dr. Bearman continues to stress the importance of reading the drafts and making comments regarding library services.

Judy Druse reported on the high increases in library usage statistics this fall. Compared to the same time period last fall library usage has increased 24%; 18,000 patrons used library services in September; Libraries electronic resources had over 2 million hits in September; Mabee Library’s IS170 course has over 300 students enrolled this Fall, a 66.5% increase from last year; CRC circulation increased 79% over the same period last year and patrons checked out 1,700 items for an all time high.
