The following matrix establishes required color differentiation between sports and graphics. Final colors are subject to approval by Washburn University Athletics and Facilities.

### Color Performance Requirements

- All paints shall be compatible with the gym floor finish system.
- Line paint shall not create raised edges or alter floor traction.
- Colors must remain visually distinct under broadcast and competition lighting.
