THE STATE OF KANSAS TO THE SHERIFF OF FINNEY COUNTY:

WHEREAS, Complaint in writing under oath, has been made to me, and it appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that on or about the 15th day of NOVEMBER, 1959, in

FINNEY County and State of Kansas, one RICHARD EUGENE HICKOCK and

PERRY EDWARD SMITH

did then and there unlawfully, feloniously and willfully and with deliberation and premeditation, and while being engaged in the perpetration of a felony, kill and take the life of Herbert W. Clutter.

COUNT TWO

That on or about the 15th day of November, 1959, in the County of Finney and the State of Kansas, the said Richard Eugene Hickock and Perry Edward Smith did then and there unlawfully, feloniously and wilfully, and with deliberation and premeditation, and while being engaged in the perpetration of a felony, kill and take the life of Bonnie Mae Clutter.

COUNT THREE

That on or about the 15th day of November, 1959 in the County of Finney and state of Kansas, the said Richard Eugene Hickock and Perry Edward Smith did then and there unlawfully, feloniously and wilfully, and with deliberation and premeditation, and while being engaged in the perpetration of a felony, kill and take the life of Nancy Mae Clutter.

COUNT FOUR

That on or about the 15th day of November, 1959, in the County of Finney and State of Kansas, the said Ricard Eugene Hickock and Perry Edward Smith did then and there unlawfully, feloniously and willfully, and with deliberation and premeditation, and while being engaged in the perpetration of a felony, kill and take the life of Kenyon Neal Clutter.

You Are Therefore Commanded, forthwith, to arrest said Richard Eugene Hickock and Perry Edward Smith

and bring them before me, at Garden City, in said County, to be dealt with according to law; and then and there return this writ.
