his father say ,bitterly, by a vengefulm God for something he had not, knowingly, done. Today plastic surgery could give him a new face. It viseems entirely possible that the dissidence and general eccentricity of his later years, and even the final tragedy, were incubated in the resentful loneliness of his youth.

I have not forgotten my promise to write something about the Ft.Rily school for you, Mr.Jeffries. I tend to remember things in vignettes and translating them into readable form is a bit frustrating. I'll manage something soon, however. I felt I wanted to clear the slate a little for Robert Henderson if I could. I knew him only slightly but found him alert and intelligent. With two good eyes and a lot less bitterness in the background his life might have been triumphant, not tragic.
