	Phase I (NIMS type 4 or 5 incident) Emergency management increased readiness	Phase II (NIMS type 3, 4 or 5 incident) Inter-department coordination & increased readiness	Phase III: (NIMS type 2 or 1 incident) EOC activation
Trigger	Director of University Police or Director of Safety & Emergency Planning is made aware of an emerging situation with the potential for gradual escalation which requires monitoring	Situation originates at, or intensifies to, a stage where cross-service interaction of two or more departments or outside support organizations would be aided by direct contact of their EOC representatives.	Proportions and/or demands of situation are of such initial magnitude, or have heightened to a stage, that an immediate or full emergency response is required.

Emergency plan status	University Police monitors at normal status, with directors of University Police and Safety & Emergency Planning on call.	Typically implements the crisis management procedures.	Implements the disaster response procedures.
