STATUS: Internal Affairs Committee and Allocations Committee-Pending

WHEREAS: The Constitution and By-Laws are the governing documents of the Washburn Student Government Association, and

WHEREAS: It is important that WSGA keep these documents up to date and reflective of best practices, and

WHEREAS: The Payroll section of the Constitution and By-Laws have not been kept up to date, and

WHEREAS: The Diversity and Inclusion Director and the Homecoming Director have not been put in the Constitution and By-Laws, and

WHEREAS: In the past ten years, there has not been a salary increase to follow the rise in student activity fee, and

WHEREAS: Some positions do more than the allotted hours of work each week.

WHEREAS: Washburn Student Government Association is the lowest paying government association in the Student Advisory Committee Schools.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE: The By-Laws of the Washburn Student Government Association shall be amended to reflect a payroll increase for the Cabinet and Committee Chairs.

SECTION TWO: The By-Laws of the Washburn Student Government Association shall be amended to read as indicated by the attached amendment document, coded in Purple.

SECTION THREE: These amendments shall become effective immediately after passage by the Senate.

SECTION ONE: The Washburn Student Government Association shall increase the proposed allotted money of salaries for the spring semester of 2021 from \$48,000 to \$63,000.

SECTION TWO: Upon following all rules stated in the constitution, WSGA shall not discriminate up race, sex, religion, creed, age, national origin, sexual orientation, academic major, or level of undergraduate study.

SECTION THREE: This bill shall be effective upon passage.

STATUS: Internal Affairs Committee-Pending

WHEREAS: The Constitution and By-Laws are the governing documents of the Washburn Student Government Association, and

WHEREAS: It is important that WSGA keep these documents up to date and reflective of best practices, and

WHEREAS: The agenda of the Senate is currently decided upon by the administrative assistant, and

WHEREAS: In the future, this could be problematic as well as lead to abuse of power by the executive branch, and

WHEREAS: In order to abide fully by the duties laid out in the constitution, the legislative branch should have the power to set the agenda as it was intended.

WHEREAS: Internal affairs shall decide what is placed on the agenda with a majority vote before it's sent out, taking on the duty that previously was the administrative assistant's.

WHEREAS: The criteria for striking a bill of the agenda should be as following a direct violation of school rules or in direct conflict with the constitution unless it's being presented as an amendment.
